# RCS Cajun Cook-Off

## RULES:

1. Entry Fee: \$50. Must be submitted by October 20<sup>th</sup> to guarantee your t-shirt on cook-off day.
2. Corporate Entry Fee: \$100, which includes your cook-off entry fee, custom sign for your cooking area, and your company/sponsor name on the cook-off t-shirt. Must be submitted by October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017
3. The cook-off site will open at 6 a.m. for registration and set up. A mandatory team meeting with cook-off officials will be at 6:45 a.m. to review rules. The competition begins at 7 a.m. Teams will begin serving at noon, so don't be late.
4. Teams will be assigned a preparation area.
5. Each team is responsible for all cooking utensils, tables, chairs, cooking ingredients, set up and clean up.
6. Each team must supply all cooking equipment: propane camp stove, grills, generators, etc. (electrical outlets are available but are limited and water will be available).
7. No dish can be pre-cooked prior to competition. All food will be inspected by cook-off officials before cooking will begin.
8. A sanitation station to wash, rinse utensils and hands will also be set up for use. Please keep pot lids tightly covered when not serving.
10. Each contestant will be assigned a bucket for collecting the voting tickets along with Styrofoam bowls and spoons for tasting.
11. This will be a "People Choice" competition. The public will select the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. The public will each be given 3 tickets to give to their favorite dish and/or team. The team with the most tickets wins. It's up to you to entice them to try your dish and cast their vote for you. The more sauce/roux/gravy you have, the more votes you can get – but a minimum of 4 gallons is required.
12. Judges will announce the Cajun Cook Off Winner around 2pm. The winning team will be presented with an fabulous prize.
13. Teams are encouraged, urged and otherwise motivated to decorate their area and themselves
